Project FAQ

How long will construction take?

• Weather permitting, the project is scheduled to start on June 5 and is expected to last into August.

What type of work is being done?

- Pavement resurfacing
- City utilities/sewer (storm, water, sanitary)
- Sidewalks, curb and gutters
- Pedestrian ramps and audible signals

How will I access the businesses along Hwy 2?

• Off highway parking area's will be located in the blocks adjacent to highway 2. Signs denoting business parking area's will be located along the project area.

Why is there a detour for eastbound traffic?

• The width of the highway is not enough to handle shifting both lanes of traffic during construction because the utility work requires more room. Utilyzing a one-way only temporary detour for the eastbound traffic allows for the least disruption to commuters, residents and business owners.

How will the temporary road be built?

• The contractor will begin the project by building a temporary road out of gravel, which will also be treated to maintain the integrity of the driving surface. That will also help to keep down sand and dust. The road will be located south of the businesses along Hwy 2 near the railroad tracks.

Will the temporary road remain after the project is complete?

• No, the road will be removed when construction is complete.

How much will my assessments be as a result of the replacement of public utilities?

• Special assessment fee's are administered by the City of Deer River. Please contact the Public Works department.


